Attach the magnetic cap to the top of a tin can, bottle, spray or storage container.

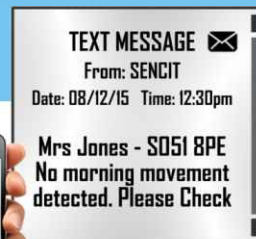

Talking PIR Motion Sensors

Create an audible reminder or a comforting message that will playback automatically after the PIR sensor has been activated.

Play an audible caution for a hazardous area or offer support with step by step instructions.

SeNCit will monitor movement patterns and alert a relative or carer by sending a warning text message when it detects 'no movement' within the house at times when you would most expect it.

The individual does not have to raise the alarm themselves - it is automatic.

The system can also check for room temperature changes, power cuts and night wandering.

The SENCit Plus version comes with a wireless door sensor to monitor wandering via external doors, and a 'Bogus Caller' SOS Button.
